Our Year In Numbers




The IGS Foundation continued progress in 2024 with several notable items. This included repeat donations from several of the Foundation's Founding Donors and new donors from France, China, India, Australia, the USA, continuing to expand the scope of participants from new global geosynthetic markets.

The Foundations accounts continue to support the resources needed for geosynthetic advancement and educational and market growth. Disbursements exceeded income in 2024 but a small reserve remains, however the Foundation needs additional donations to continue to survive. We welcome new donors as listed on following pages and offer special thanks to FR Liners and FC Geosynthetics for their annual donations in each year of the Foundation's existence.

In addition to the annual summary listed on this page, I would like to offer a brief summary of the activities over the 5 years of the Foundation's activity. The Foundation has supported 7 Educate the Educator events facilitating over 300 professors to teach geosynthetics in their respective engineering communities. 240 or more students have been able to attend geosynthetic technical conferences, 90 or more have used job shadowing programs and other project/site visits to learn the capabilities of geosynthetic materials. 20 or more hours of geosynthetic knowledge has been digitized for web use including the Educate the Educator lecture, and multiple lectures on transportation, containment, hydraulic and sustainability topics and additional contributions to diversity, creation of a new IGS Handbook and other initiatives to expand geosynthetics use. The Foundation has improved and expanded the IGS's mission and activity and deserves your support.






